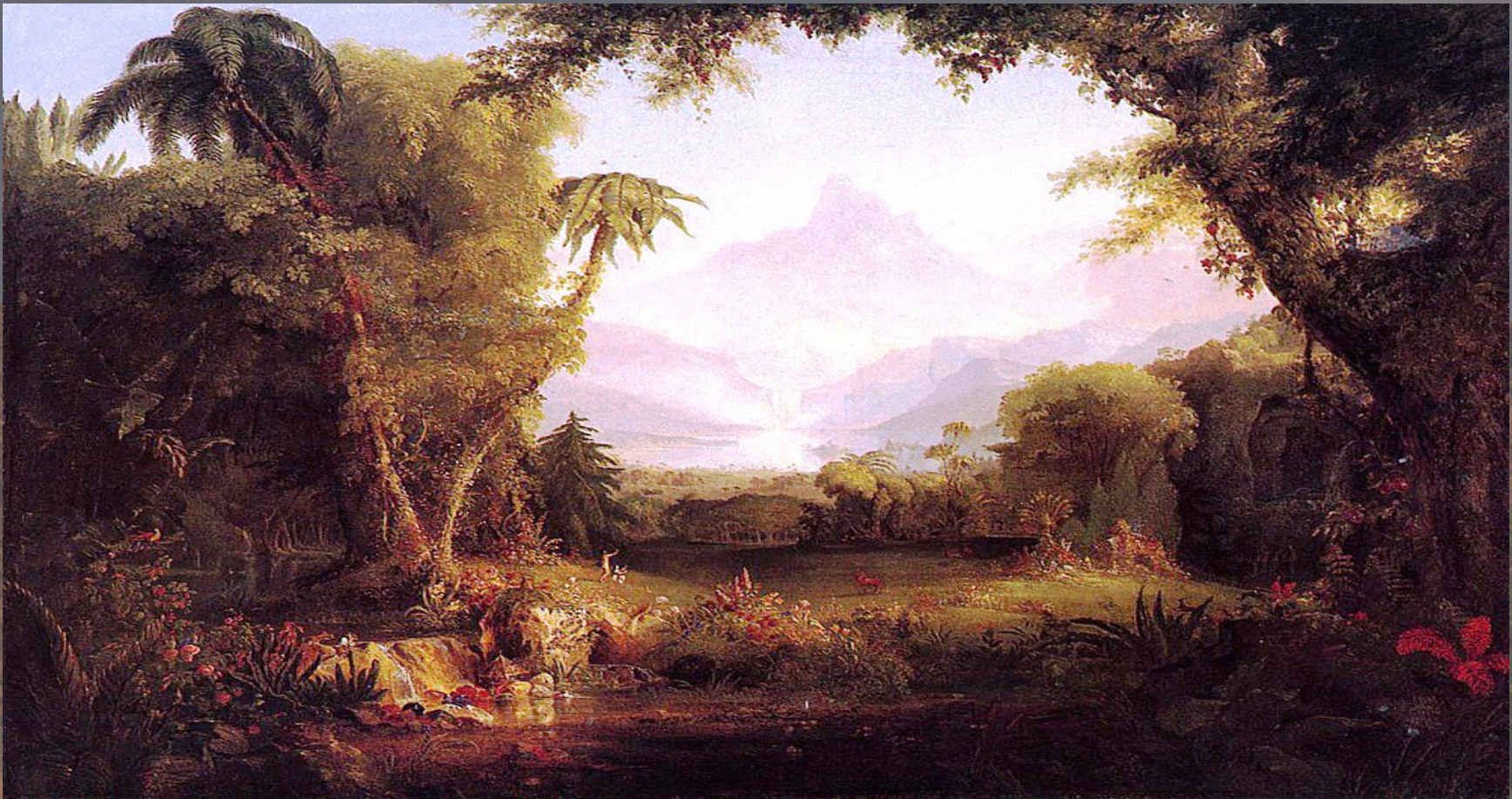
# Brief Tour of Human History

Gen 3:1 Now the serpent was more crafty than any beast of the field which the Lord God had made. And he said to the woman, “Indeed, has God said, ‘You shall not eat from any tree of the garden’?”



Gen 3:17-22 Then to Adam He said, “Because you  
have listened to the voice of your wife, and have  
eaten from the tree about which I commanded you,  
saying, ‘You shall not eat from it’;  
Cursed is the ground because of you;  
In toil you will eat of it  
All the days of your life.

18 “Both thorns and thistles it shall grow for you;  
And you will eat the plants of the field;  
19 By the sweat of your face  
You will eat bread,  
Till you return to the ground,  
Because from it you were taken;  
For you are dust,  
And to dust you shall return.”





20 Now the man called his wife's name Eve,  
because she was the mother of all *the* living. 21  
The Lord God made garments of skin for Adam  
and his wife, and clothed them.  
22 Then the Lord God said, "Behold, the man has  
become like one of Us, knowing good and evil;  
and now, he might stretch out his hand, and take  
also from the tree of life, and eat, and live  
forever"— 23 therefore the Lord God sent him out

from which he was taken.



# The flood

Gen 6:3 3 Then the Lord said, "My Spirit shall not strive with man forever, because he also is flesh; nevertheless his days shall be one hundred and twenty years."

Gen 6:5-8 Then the Lord saw that the wickedness of man was great on the earth, and that every intent of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. 6 The Lord was sorry that He had made man on the earth, and He was grieved in His heart. 7 The Lord said, "I will blot out man whom I have created from the face of the land, from man to animals to creeping things and to birds of the sky; for I am sorry that I have made them." 8 But Noah found favor in the eyes of the Lord.



# Children of Israel

Ex 19:36 4 ‘You yourselves have seen what I did to the Egyptians, and *how* I bore you on eagles’ wings, and brought you to Myself. 5 Now then, if you will indeed obey My voice and keep My covenant, then you shall be My own possession among all the peoples, for all the earth is Mine; 6 and you shall be to Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.’ These are the words that you shall speak to the sons of Israel.”



# Children of Israel

Ex 32:1 Now when the people saw that Moses delayed to come down from the mountain, the people assembled about Aaron and said to him, “Come, make us a god who will go before us; as for this Moses, the man who brought us up from the land of Egypt, we do not know what has become of him.”



# Children of Israel

Ex 32:26-28 26 then Moses stood in the gate of the camp, and said, “Whoever is for the Lord, *come* to me!” And all the sons of Levi gathered together to him. 27 He said to them, “Thus says the Lord, the God of Israel, ‘Every man *of you* put his sword upon his thigh, and go back and forth from gate to gate in the camp, and kill every man his brother, and every man his friend, and every man his neighbor.’” 28 So the sons of Levi did as Moses instructed, and about three thousand men of the people fell that day.



# Children of Israel

Num 8:5-6 5 Again the Lord spoke to Moses, saying,  
6 “Take the Levites from among the sons of Israel  
and cleanse them.

Num 8:10-11 10 and present the Levites before the  
Lord; and the sons of Israel shall lay their hands on  
the Levites. 11 Aaron then shall present the Levites  
before the Lord as a wave offering from the sons of  
Israel, that they may qualify to perform the service  
of the Lord.



# Children of Israel

Num 8:18-19 But I have taken the Levites instead of every firstborn among the sons of Israel. 19 I have given the Levites as a gift to Aaron and to his sons from among the sons of Israel, to perform the service of the sons of Israel at the tent of meeting and to make atonement on behalf of the sons of Israel, so that there will be no plague among the sons of Israel by their coming near to the sanctuary.”



# Nadab and Abihu

Lev 10:1-2 1 Now Nadab and Abihu, the sons of Aaron, took their respective firepans, and after putting fire in them, placed incense on it and offered strange fire before the Lord, which He had not commanded them. 2 And fire came out from the presence of the Lord and consumed them, and they died before the Lord



# Nadab and Abihu

Lev 16:1-3 16 Now the Lord spoke to Moses after the death of the two sons of Aaron, when they had approached the presence of the Lord and died. 2 The Lord said to Moses: “Tell your brother Aaron that he shall not enter at any time into the holy place inside the veil, before the mercy seat which is on the ark, or he will die; for I will appear in the cloud over the mercy seat. 3 Aaron shall enter the holy place with this: with a bull for a sin offering and a ram for a burnt offering.



# Removal of Israel

2 Chron. 6: 36-39 36 “When they sin against You (for there is no man who does not sin) and You are angry with them and deliver them to an enemy, so that they take them away captive to a land far off or near, 37 if they take thought in the land where they are taken captive, and repent and make supplication to You in the land of their captivity, saying, ‘We have sinned, we have committed iniquity and have acted wickedly’; 38 if they return to You with all their heart and with all their soul in the land of their captivity, where they have been taken captive, and pray toward their land which You have given to their fathers and the city which You have chosen, and toward the house which I have built for Your name, 39 then hear from heaven, from Your dwelling place, their prayer and supplications, and maintain their cause and forgive Your people who have sinned against You.

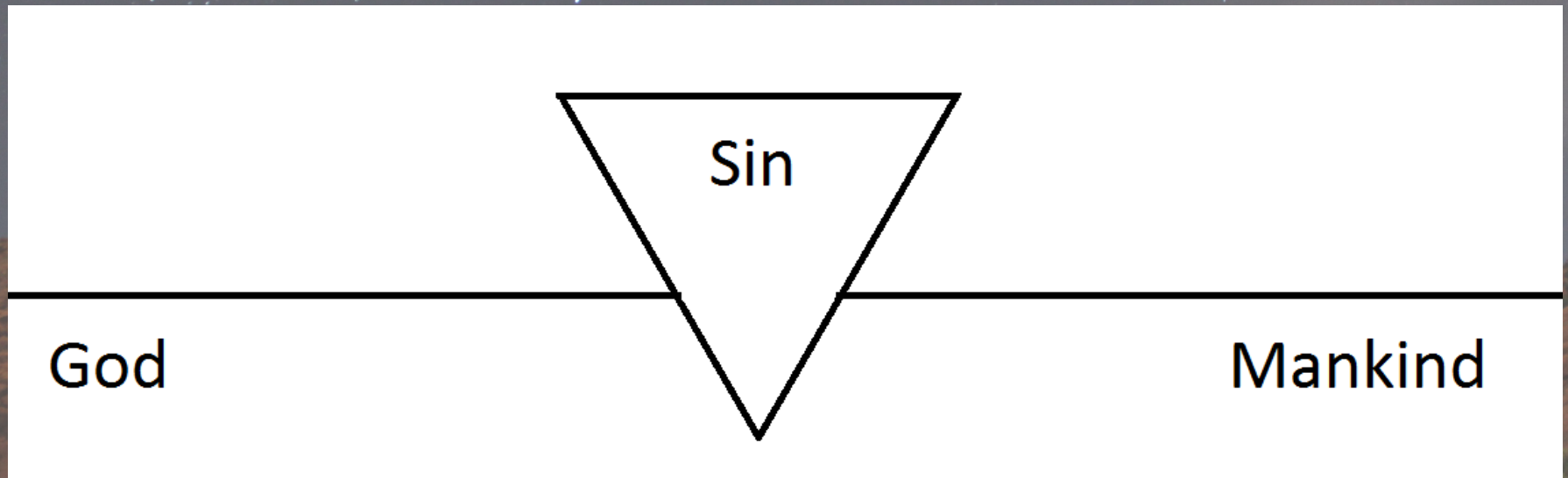


# Wedge of Sin

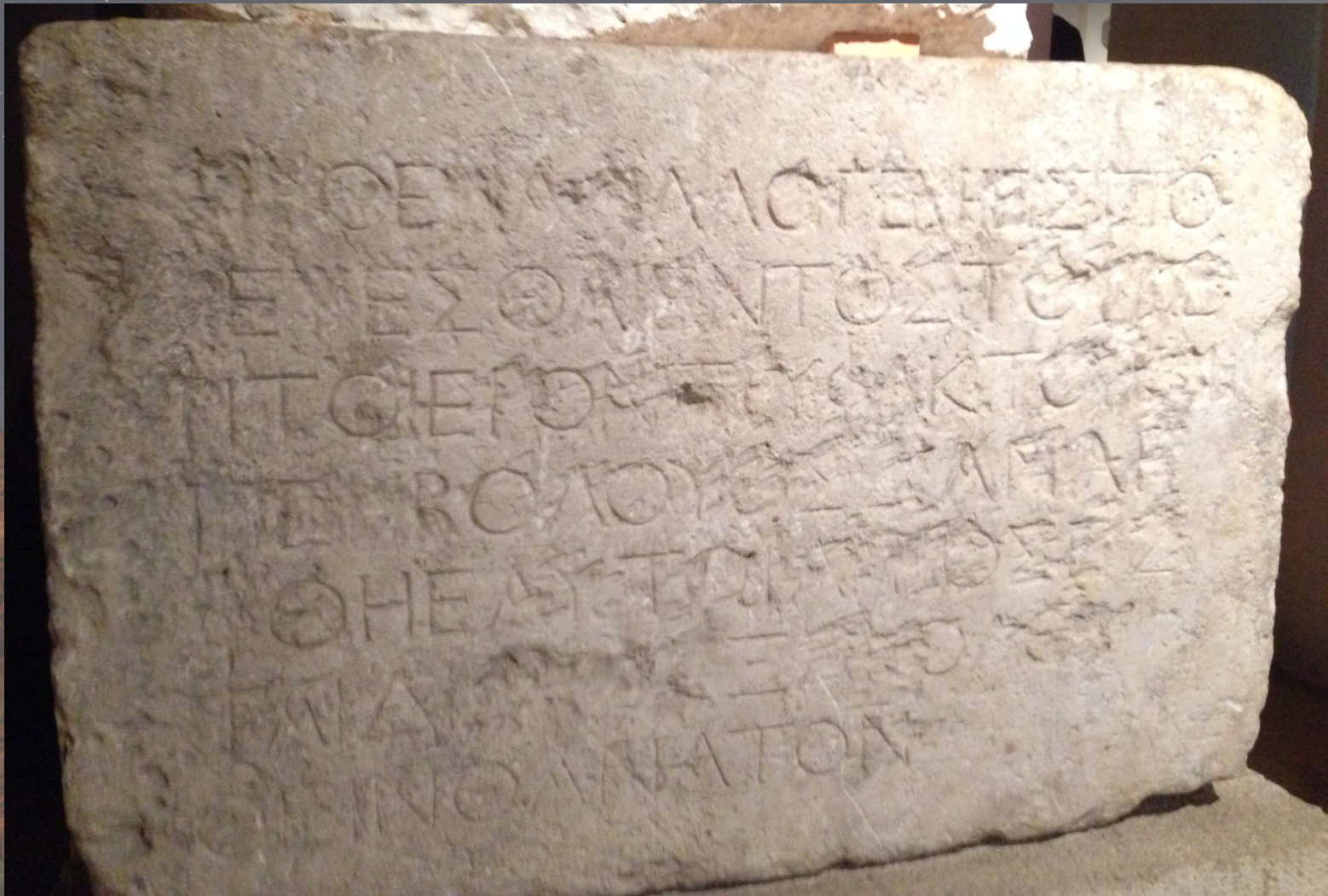
# Plan of Restoration


# Passover

Lev 23:4-5 4‘These are the appointed times of the Lord, holy convocations which you shall proclaim at the times appointed for them. 5 In the first month, on the fourteenth day of the month at twilight is the Lord’s Passover

Ex 12:3 Speak to all the congregation of Israel, saying, ‘On the tenth of this month they are each one to take a lamb for themselves, according to their fathers’ households, a lamb for each household.

Ex 12:13 The blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you live; and when I see the blood I will pass over you, and no plague will befall you to destroy *you* when I strike the land of Egypt.






Lev 17:11 For the life of the flesh is in the blood,  
and I have given it to you on the altar to make

## Matt 27:50-51

50 And Jesus cried out again with a loud voice, and yielded up His spirit. 51 And behold, the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom; and the earth shook and the rocks were split

## Heb 10:19-22


19 Therefore, brethren, since we have confidence to enter the holy place by the blood of Jesus, 20 by a new and living way which He inaugurated for us through the veil, that is, His flesh, 21 and since we *have* a great priest over the house of God, 22 let us draw near with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled *clean* from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.



# Pentecost

Lev 23:15-17 15 'You shall also count for yourselves from the day after the sabbath, from the day when you brought in the sheaf of the wave offering; there shall be seven complete sabbaths. 16 You shall count fifty days to the day after the seventh sabbath; then you shall present a new grain offering to the Lord. 17 You shall bring in from your dwelling places two *loaves* of bread for a wave offering, made of two-tenths *of an ephah*; they shall be of a fine flour, baked with leaven as first fruits to the Lord.






Acts 1:4-5 4 Gathering them together, He commanded them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait for what the Father had promised, “Which,” *He said*, “you heard of from Me; 5 for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now.”



## Acts 2:14-17

14 But Peter, taking his stand with the eleven, raised his voice and declared to them: “Men of Judea and all you who live in Jerusalem, let this be known to you and give heed to my words. 15 For these men are not drunk, as you suppose, for it is *only* the third hour of the day; 16 but this is what was spoken of through the prophet Joel: 17 ‘And it shall be in the last days,’ God says, ‘That I will pour forth of My Spirit on all mankind; And your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, And your young men shall see visions, And your old men shall dream dreams;





Acts 2:41 So then, those who had received his word were baptized; and that day there were added about three thousand souls.

Ex 32:28 So the sons of Levi did as Moses instructed, and about three thousand men of the people fell that day.



1 Pe 2:9 But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for God's own possession, so that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;

Gal 3:8 The Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel beforehand to Abraham, saying, "All the nations will be blessed in you."



# Trumpets

Lev 23:23-25 Again the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, 24 “Speak to the sons of Israel, saying, ‘In the seventh month on the first of the month you shall have a rest, a reminder by blowing *of trumpets*, a holy convocation. 25 You shall not do any laborious work, but you shall present an offering by fire to the Lord.’”



Matt 24:31 And He will send forth His angels with a great trumpet and they will gather together His elect from the four winds, from one end of the sky to the other.

1 Cor 15:52 in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet; for the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed.

1 Thess 4:16 For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of *the* archangel and with the trumpet of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first.



# Day of Atonement

Lev 23:26-28

26 The Lord spoke to Moses, saying, 27 “On exactly the tenth day of this seventh month is the day of atonement; it shall be a holy convocation for you, and you shall humble your souls and present an offering by fire to the Lord. 28 You shall not do any work on this same day, for it is a day of atonement, to make atonement on your behalf before the Lord your God.



# Jubilee

Lev 25: 8-10 'You are also to count off seven sabbaths of years for yourself, seven times seven years, so that you have the time of the seven sabbaths of years, *namely*, forty-nine years. 9 You shall then sound a ram's horn abroad on the tenth day of the seventh month; on the day of atonement you shall sound a horn all through your land. 10 You shall thus consecrate the fiftieth year and proclaim a release through the land to all its inhabitants. It shall be a jubilee for you, and each of you shall return to his own property, and each of you shall return to his family.



# Feast of Tabernacles

Lev 23:33 Again the Lord spoke to Moses, saying,  
34 “Speak to the sons of Israel, saying, ‘On the  
fifteenth of this seventh month is the Feast of  
Booths for seven days to the Lord. 35 On the first  
day is a holy convocation; you shall do no  
laborious work of any kind. 36 For seven days  
you shall present an offering by fire to the Lord.  
On the eighth day you shall have a holy  
convocation and present an offering by fire to the  
Lord; it is an assembly. You shall do no laborious  
work.



Duet 16:13-15 13 “You shall celebrate the Feast of Booths seven days after you have gathered in from your threshing floor and your wine vat; 14 and you shall rejoice in your feast, you and your son and your daughter and your male and female servants and the Levite and the stranger and the orphan and the widow who are in your towns. 15 Seven days you shall celebrate a feast to the Lord your God in the place which the Lord chooses, because the Lord your God will bless you in all your produce and in all the work of your hands, so that you will be altogether joyful.

# Why the millennium?

Isaiah 4:5-6 then the Lord will create over the whole area of Mount Zion and over her assemblies a cloud by day, even smoke, and the brightness of a flaming fire by night; for over all the glory will be a **canopy**. 6 There will be a shelter to *give* shade from the heat by day, and refuge and protection from the storm and the rain.



# Why the millennium?

Amos 9:11-12 11 “In that day I will raise up the fallen  
**booth** of David,  
And wall up its breaches;  
I will also raise up its ruins  
And rebuild it as in the days of old;  
12 That they may possess the remnant of Edom  
And all the nations who are called by My name,”  
Declares the Lord who does this.



# Why the millennium?

Lev 23:40-43 40 Now on the first day you shall take for yourselves the foliage of beautiful trees, palm branches and boughs of leafy trees and willows of the brook, and you shall rejoice before the Lord your God for seven days. 41 You shall thus celebrate it *as* a feast to the Lord for seven days in the year. It *shall be* a perpetual statute throughout your generations; you shall celebrate it in the seventh month. 42 You shall live in booths for seven days; all the native-born in Israel shall live in booths, 43 so that your generations may know that I had the sons of Israel live in booths when I brought them out from the land of Egypt. I am the Lord your God.””



## Jeremiah 2:2-3

2 “Go and proclaim in the ears of Jerusalem,  
saying, ‘Thus says the Lord,  
“I remember concerning you the devotion of your  
youth,  
The love of your betrothals,  
Your following after Me in the wilderness,  
Through a land not sown.  
3 “Israel was holy to the Lord,  
The first of His harvest.  
All who ate of it became guilty;  
Evil came upon them,” declares the Lord.”



# Why the millennium?


Zech 14:16-19 16 Then it will come about that any who are left of all the nations that went against Jerusalem will go up from year to year to worship the King, the Lord of hosts, and to celebrate the Feast of Booths. 17 And it will be that whichever of the families of the earth does not go up to Jerusalem to worship the King, the Lord of hosts, there will be no rain on them. 18 If the family of Egypt does not go up or enter, then no *rain will fall* on them; it will be the plague with which the Lord smites the nations who do not go up to celebrate the Feast of Booths. 19 This will be the punishment of Egypt, and the punishment of all the nations who do not go up to celebrate the Feast of Booths.



# Why the millennium?

- The protection over Jerusalem during the millennium is a tabernacle.
- During the millenium the tabernacle of David is being rebuilt.
- Lev 23 associates the wandering of Israel to this feast, the next time people will be directly lead by Christ as they were in the wilderness will be the millennium
- Tabernacles is directly associated with the millennium in Zechariah
- During the Feast it appears as if the offerings are being offered for all nations.
- Harvest imagery Unleavened Bread → Pentecost → Tabernacles

And the lion will eat straw like the ox.

8 The nursing child will play by the hole of the cobra,

# Led by Christ


Isaiah 2:2-4 2 Now it will come about that  
In the last days

The mountain of the house of the Lord  
Will be established as the chief of the mountains,  
And will be raised above the hills;  
And all the nations will stream to it.

3 And many peoples will come and say,  
“Come, let us go up to the mountain of the Lord,  
To the house of the God of Jacob;  
That He may teach us concerning His ways  
And that we may walk in His paths.”

For the law will go forth from Zion  
And the word of the Lord from Jerusalem.





4 And He will judge between the nations,  
And will render decisions for many peoples;  
And they will hammer their swords into plowshares and  
their spears into pruning hooks.  
Nation will not lift up sword against nation,  
And never again will they learn war.

Amos 9:13-15 13 “Behold, days are coming,” declares the Lord, “When the plowman will overtake the reaper And the treader of grapes him who sows seed; When the mountains will drip sweet wine And all the hills will be dissolved. 14 “Also I will restore the captivity of My people Israel, And they will rebuild the ruined cities and live *in them*; They will also plant vineyards and drink their wine, And make gardens and eat their fruit. 15 “I will also plant them on their land, And they will not again be rooted out from their land Which I have given them,” Says the Lord your God.

Lev 23:36 For seven days you shall present an offering by fire to the Lord. On the eighth day you shall have a holy convocation and present an offering by fire to the Lord; it is an assembly. You shall do no laborious work



# Completion

Rev 21:3 And I heard a loud voice from the throne, saying, “Behold, the tabernacle of God is among men, and He will dwell among them, and they shall be His people, and God Himself will be among them

Rev 22:1-2 1 Then he showed me a river of the water of life, clear as crystal, coming from the throne of God and of the Lamb, 2 in the middle of its street. On either side of the river was the tree of life, bearing twelve *kinds of* fruit, yielding its fruit every month; and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations.
