On the eighth day you shall have a holy convocation and present an offering by fire to the LORD; it is an assembly. You shall do no laborious work.

22nd of Tishri Shemini Atzeret

Shemini Atzeret - literally "Eighth [day of] Assembly"

Shemini - means the eight; in general, the number eight symbolizes perfection

Atzeret - means "holding back," or that which is held back for the purpose of bring it to its state of completion

1 Corinthians 15:24-26

Death to Eternal Life?

Hebrews 9:26-28

27 And inasmuch as it is appointed for men to die once and after this comes judgment, 28 so Christ also, having been offered once to bear the sins of many, will appear a second time for salvation without reference to sin, to those who eagerly await Him.

Why Death In The First Place?

Genesis 3:17-19

17 Then to Adam He said, "Because you have listened to the voice of your wife, and have eaten from the tree about which I commanded you, saying, 'You shall not eat from it'; Cursed is the ground because of you; In toil you will eat of it All the days of your life. 18 "Both thorns and thistles it shall grow for you; And you will eat the plants of the field; 19 By the sweat of your face You will eat bread, Till you return to the ground, Because from it you were taken; For you are dust, And to dust you shall return." (NASU)

Sin - Death?

Ezekiel 18:4, 20

- 4 "Behold, all souls are Mine; the soul of the father as well as the soul of the son is Mine. The soul who sins will die.
- 20 "The person who sins will die. The son will not bear the punishment for the father's iniquity, nor will the father bear the punishment for the son's iniquity; the righteousness of the righteous will be upon himself, and the wickedness of the wicked will be upon himself.

Dictionary of Biblical Imagery – General Editors -Leland Ryken, James C. Wilhoit, Temper Longman III

Scripture portrays God's judgements throughout history as proleptic pictures of the final judgement. God's judgement is depicted as coming in stages on a divine installment plan. In one sense the impenitent are judged already (John 3:18), yet God's present partial judgements on societies and individuals are meant to function as a merciful warning to them to renounce evil and submit to God (Amos 4:6-13; Romans 1:18-25; Romans 2:1-4; See also Ezekiel's repeated refrain, "then you/they will know that I am the Lord" [Ezekiel 5:8-13; 6:8-10; 16:59-63]). The number of installments is limited.
