Leviticus 23:41-43

[41] And ye shall keep it a feast unto YHWH seven days in the year. It shall be a statute for ever in your generations: ye shall celebrate it in the seventh month. [42] Ye shall dwell in booths seven days; all that are Israelites born shall dwell in booths: [43] That your generations may know that I made the children of Israel to dwell in booths, when I brought them out of the land of Egypt: I am YHWH your Elohim.

SUKKOT AND THE CLOUD OF GLORY

Ezekiel 34:1-10

[1] And the word of YHWH came unto me, saying, [2] Son of man, prophesy against the shepherds of Israel, prophesy, and say unto them, Thus saith YHWH Elohim unto the shepherds; Woe be to the shepherds of Israel that do feed themselves! should not the shepherds feed the flocks? [3] Ye eat the fat, and ye clothe you with the wool, ye kill them that are fed: but ye feed not the flock. [4] The diseased have ye not strengthened, neither have ye healed that which was sick, neither have ye bound up that which was broken, neither have ye brought again that which was driven away, neither have ye sought that which was lost; but with force and with cruelty have ye ruled them. [5] And they were scattered, because there is no shepherd: and they became meat to all the beasts of the field, when they were scattered. [6] My sheep wandered through all the mountains, and upon every high hill: yea, my flock was scattered upon all the face of the earth, and none did search or seek after them. [7] Therefore, ye shepherds, hear the word of the LORD; [8] As I live, saith YHWH Elohim, surely because my flock became a prey, and my flock became meat to every beast of the field, because there was no shepherd, neither did my shepherds search for my flock, but the shepherds fed themselves, and fed not my flock; [9] Therefore, O ye shepherds, hear the word of YHWH; [10] Thus saith YHWH Elohim; Behold, I am against the shepherds; and I will require my flock at their hand, and cause them to cease from feeding the flock; neither shall the shepherds feed themselves any more; for I will deliver my flock from their mouth, that they may not be meat for them.

Exodus 25:8-9

[8] And let them make me a sanctuary; that I may dwell among them.

[9] According to all that I shew thee, after the pattern of the tabernacle, and the pattern of all the instruments thereof, even so shall ye make it.

SUKKOT AND THE CLOUD OF GLORY

Exodus 40:34

[34] Then a cloud covered the tent of the congregation, and the glory of YHWH filled the tabernacle.

SUKKOT AND THE CLOUD OF GLORY

Exodus 40:35-38

[35] And Moses was not able to enter into the tent of the congregation, because the cloud abode thereon, and the glory of YHWH filled the tabernacle. [36] And when the cloud was taken up from over the tabernacle, the children of Israel went onward in all their journeys: [37] But if the cloud were not taken up, then they journeyed not till the day that it was taken up. [38] For the cloud of YHWH was upon the tabernacle by day, and fire was on it by night, in the sight of all the house of Israel, throughout all their journeys.

SUKKOT AND THE CLOUD OF GLORY

II Corinthians 5:1-3

[1] For we know that if our earthly house of this tabernacle were dissolved, we have a building of Elohim, an house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens. [2] For in this we groan, earnestly desiring to be clothed upon with our house which is from heaven: [3] If so be that being clothed we shall not be found naked.

SUKKOT AND THE CLOUD OF GLORY

Ezekiel 16:15-16

[15] But thou didst trust in thine own beauty, and playedst the harlot because of thy renown, and pouredst out thy fornications on every one that passed by; his it was. [16] And of thy garments thou didst take, and deckedst thy high places with divers colours, and playedst the harlot thereupon: the like things shall not come, neither shall it be so.

SUKKOT AND THE CLOUD OF GLORY

I Samuel 2:12, 22

[12] Now the sons of Eli were sons of Belial (Satan); they knew not YHWH.

[22] Now Eli was very old, and heard all that his sons did unto all Israel; and how they lay with the women that assembled at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation.

SUKKOT AND THE CLOUD OF GLORY

I Samuel 4:21- 22

[21] And she named the child I-chabod, saying, The glory is departed from Israel: because the ark of Elohim was taken, and because of her father in law and her husband.

[22] And she said, The glory is departed from Israel: for the ark of Elohim is taken.

SUKKOT AND THE CLOUD OF GLORY

I Chronicles 28:2-3

[2] Then David the king stood up upon his feet, and said, Hear me, my brethren, and my people: As for me, I had in mine heart to build an house of rest for the ark of the covenant of YHWH, and for the footstool of our Elohim, and had made ready for the building: [3] But Elohim said unto me, Thou shalt not build an house for my name, because thou hast been a man of war, and hast shed blood.

SUKKOT AND THE CLOUD OF GLORY

I Chronicles 28:11-13

[11] Then David gave to Solomon his son the pattern of the porch, and of the houses thereof, and of the treasuries thereof, and of the upper chambers thereof, and of the inner parlours thereof, and of the place of the mercy seat, [12] And the pattern of all that he had by the spirit, of the courts of the house of YHWH, and of all the chambers round about, of the treasuries of the house of Elohim, and of the treasuries of the dedicated things: [13] Also for the courses of the priests and the Levites, and for all the work of the service of the house of YHWH, and for all the vessels of service in the house of YHWH.

SUKKOT AND THE CLOUD OF GLORY

I Kings 6:1

[1] And it came to pass in the four hundred and eightieth year after the children of Israel were come out of the land of Egypt, in the fourth year of Solomon's reign over Israel, in the month Zif, which is the second month, that he began to build the house of YHWH.

SUKKOT AND THE CLOUD OF GLORY

I Kings 7:51

[51] So was ended all the work that king Solomon made for the house of YHWH. And Solomon brought in the things which David his father had dedicated; even the silver, and the gold, and the vessels, did he put among the treasures of the house of YHWH.

SUKKOT AND THE CLOUD OF GLORY

II Chronicles 5:2-3

[2] Then Solomon assembled the elders of Israel, and all the heads of the tribes, the chief of the fathers of the children of Israel, unto Jerusalem, to bring up the ark of the covenant of YHWH out of the city of David, which is Zion. [3] Wherefore all the men of Israel assembled themselves unto the king in the feast which was in the seventh month.

SUKKOT AND THE CLOUD OF GLORY

II Chronicles 5:13-14

[13] It came even to pass, as the trumpeters and singers were as one, to make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking YHWH; and when they lifted up their voice with the trumpets and cymbals and instruments of musick, and praised YHWH, saying, For he is good; for his mercy endureth for ever: that then the house was filled with a cloud, even the house of YHWH; [14] So that the priests could not stand to minister by reason of the cloud: for the glory of YHWH had filled the house of Elohim.

SUKKOT AND THE CLOUD OF GLORY

I Corinthians 6:19-20

[19] What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of Elohim, and ye are not your own?

[20] For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify Elohim in your body, and in your spirit, which are Elohim's.

SUKKOT AND THE CLOUD OF GLORY

Jeremiah 2:7-8

[7] And I brought you into a plentiful country, to eat the fruit thereof and the goodness thereof; but when ye entered, ye defiled my land, and made mine heritage an abomination. [8] The priests said not, Where is YHWH? and they that handle the law knew me not: the pastors also transgressed against me, and the prophets prophesied by Baal, and walked after things that do not profit.

SUKKOT AND THE CLOUD OF GLORY

Jeremiah 2:11-13

[11] Hath a nation changed their gods, which are yet no gods? but my people have changed their glory for that which doth not profit. [12] Be astonished, O ye heavens, at this, and be horribly afraid, be ye very desolate, saith YHWH. [13] For my people have committed two evils; they have forsaken me the fountain of living waters, and hewed them out cisterns, broken cisterns, that can hold no water.

SUKKOT AND THE CLOUD OF GLORY

Haggai 2:1-9

[1] In the seventh month, in the one and twentieth day of the month, came the word of YHWH by the prophet Haggai, saying, [2] Speak now to Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and to Joshua the son of Josedech, the high priest, and to the residue of the people, saying, [3] Who is left among you that saw this house in her first glory? and how do ye see it now? is it not in your eyes in comparison of it as nothing? [4] Yet now be strong, O Zerubbabel, saith YHWH; and be strong, O Joshua, son of Josedech, the high priest; and be strong, all ye people of the land, saith the LORD, and work: for I am with you, saith YHWH of hosts: [5] According to the word that I covenanted with you when ye came out of Egypt, so my spirit remaineth among you: fear ye not. [6] For thus saith YHWH of hosts; Yet once, it is a little while, and I will shake the heavens, and the earth, and the sea, and the dry land; [7] And I will shake all nations, and the desire of all nations shall come: and I will fill this house with glory, saith YHWH of hosts. [8] The silver is mine, and the gold is mine, saith YHWH of hosts. [9] The glory of this latter house shall be greater than of the former, saith YHWH of hosts: and in this place will I give peace, saith YHWH of hosts.

John 1:14

and the word was made flesh and dwelt among us and we beheld his glory.

SUKKOT AND THE CLOUD OF GLORY

John 2:19-21

[19] Yahshua answered and said unto them, Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up. [20] Then said the Jews, Forty and six years was this temple in building, and wilt thou rear it up in three days? [21] But he spake of the temple of his body.

SUKKOT AND THE CLOUD OF GLORY

Revelation 21:22-23

[22] And I saw no temple therein: for YHWH All Mighty and the Lamb are the **temple** of it.

[23] And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the **glory** of Elohim did lighten it, and the Lamb is the light thereof.

SUKKOT AND THE CLOUD OF GLORY

Luke 19:41-44

[41] And when he was come near, he beheld the city, and wept over it, [42] Saying, If thou hadst known, even thou, at least in this thy day, the things which belong unto thy peace! but now they are hid from thine eyes. [43] For the days shall come upon thee, that thine enemies shall cast a trench about thee, and compass thee round, and keep thee in on every side, [44] And shall lay thee even with the ground, and thy children within thee; and they shall not leave in thee one stone upon another; because thou knewest not the time of thy visitation.

SUKKOT AND THE CLOUD OF GLORY

- The glory of Elohim was upon Adam, but because of sin it departed.
- The glory of Elohim in the form of the cloud by day and the pillar of fire by night that led the children of Israel out of Egypt and their journeys to the promised land.
- When the tabernacle was completed, the glory of Elohim filled the tabernacle. But because of sin it departed

SUKKOT AND THE CLOUD OF GLORY

- So David gave instruction to Solomon to build a temple and when he dedicated it on the seventh month at Sukkot the glory of Elohim filled the temple. But because of sin it departed.
- Haggai encouraged the building of the second temple and the word came to him at Sukkot.
- Yahshua came, tabernacled among his people, because of sin, the glory of Elohim departed.

SUKKOT AND THE CLOUD OF GLORY

Psalm 102:16

[16] When YHWH shall build up Zion, he shall appear in his glory.

SUKKOT AND THE CLOUD OF GLORY

Psalm 147:2

[2] YHWH doth build up Jerusalem: he gathereth together the outcasts of Israel.

SUKKOT AND THE CLOUD OF GLORY

Isaiah 44:23

[23] Sing, O ye heavens; for YHWH hath done it: shout, ye lower parts of the earth: break forth into singing, ye mountains, O forest, and every tree therein: for YHWH hath redeemed Jacob, and glorified himself in Israel.

SUKKOT AND THE CLOUD OF GLORY

Ezekiel 39:21-25

[21] And I will set my glory among the heathen, and all the heathen shall see my judgment that I have executed, and my hand that I have laid upon them. [22] So the house of Israel shall know that I am YHWH their Elohim from that day and forward. [23] And the heathen shall know that the house of Israel went into captivity for their iniquity: because they trespassed against me, therefore hid I my face from them, and gave them into the hand of their enemies: so fell they all by the sword. [24] According to their uncleanness and according to their transgressions have I done unto them, and hid my face from them. [25] Therefore thus saith YHWH Elohim; Now will I bring again the captivity of Jacob, and have mercy upon the whole house of Israel, and will be jealous for my holy name;
